**APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:**

- High School Senior graduating in May 2020
- Must graduate from a high school within the Anchorage School District
- Filipino Heritage (at least 50%)
- Grade point average of at least 3.0
- Student must be accepted as a full-time student by either a business, trade or college institution

**The AFFA Scholarship Review Committee selects the winners based on the following scoring points:**

- 30 points - Academic Achievement/GPA
- 20 points - Essay
- 20 points – Applicant's AFFA participation (Volunteering in AFFA activities)
- 10 points - Student Leadership and/or Extracurricular Activities (ex: Student Government, Orchestra, ROTC, etc.)
- 10 points - Community Service (ex: Citywide Clean-up)
- 10 points – Parent/s current and active member of AFFA, Inc.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Photo (colored)
- \_\_\_\_\_ A Copy of High School Transcript with Cumulative GPA
- \_\_\_\_\_ Essay (No more than 500 words.) Essay must include the following:
  - Part I: Personal Information: Please include information about yourself that you would like the Selection Committee to know – where you were born, your family background, your hopes and dreams, and your plans for the future.
  - Part II: Answer the question: What does being Filipino mean to you and what have you done to promote Filipino values and traditions that are important to you?
- \_\_\_\_\_ Proof of involvement in AFFA activities, Community Services, Student Leadership, Extracurricular Activities.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Acceptance Letter from a Business, Trade or College Institution
- \_\_\_\_\_ Two Letters of Recommendations signed: one from a community member and one from a current teacher.
