APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:

- High School Senior graduating in May 2017
- Must graduate from a high school within the Anchorage School District
- Filipino Heritage (at least 50%)
- Grade point average of at least 3.0
- Student must be accepted as a full-time student by either a business, trade or college institution

The AFFA Scholarship Review Committee selects the winners based on the following scoring points:

- 30 points - Academic Achievement/GPA
- 20 points - Essay
- 20 points - AFFA participation (Volunteering in AFFA activities)
- 20 points - Student Leadership and/or Extracurricular Activities (ex: Student Government, Orchestra, ROTC, etc.)
- 10 points - Community Service (ex: Citywide Clean-up)

NOTE: Preference will be given to children of current AFFA members.

- _____ Essay (No more than 500 words.) Essay must include the following:

 - Part II: Answer the question: What does being Filipino mean to you and what have you done to promote Filipino values and traditions that are important to you?

- _____ Acceptance Letter from a Business, Trade or College Institution
- _____ Two Letters of Recommendations: one from a community member and one from a current teacher.
