APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:

- Filipino Heritage (at least 50%)
- Student must be enrolled/registered as a full-time student at an accredited business, trade or college institution
- Applicant must be at least entering 3rd year/Junior year in college
- College grade point average of at least 3.0

The AFFA Scholarship Review Committee selects the winners based on the following scoring points:

- 30 points - Academic Achievement/GPA
- 20 points - Essay
- 20 points - Applicant's AFFA participation (Volunteering in AFFA activities)
- 10 points - Student Leadership and/or Extracurricular Activities (ex: Student Government, Orchestra, ROTC, etc.)
- 10 points - Community Service (ex: Citywide Clean-up)
- 10 points - Parent/s current and active member of AFFA, Inc.
