APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:

- Filipino Heritage (at least 50%)
- Student must be enrolled/registered as a full-time 3rd year/Junior student at an accredited business, trade or college institution
- College grade point average of at least 3.0

The AFFA Scholarship Review Committee selects the winners based on the following scoring points:

- 30 points - Academic Achievement/GPA
- 20 points - Essay
- 20 points – Applicant’s AFFA participation (Volunteering in AFFA activities)
- 10 points - Student Leadership and/or Extracurricular Activities (ex: Student Government, Orchestra, ROTC, etc.)
- 10 points - Community Service (ex: Citywide Clean-up)
- 10 points – Parent/s current and active member of AFFA, Inc.

 - Part II: Answer the question: What does being Filipino mean to you and what have you done to promote Filipino values and traditions that are important to you?
- _____ Proof of involvement in AFFA activities, Community Services, Student Leadership, Extracurricular Activities.
- _____ Proof of Enrollment/Registration from a Business, Trade or College Institution
- _____ Two Letters of Recommendations signed: one from a community member and one from a current professor.
